

**Water Plant-** Public works, Todd Salazar, requested new computers for the water plant due to them being outdated and their software will be unsupported after August 1, 2026. He provided a quote from Jetco totaling \$20, 348.00. Sparrow spoke up that they were put into next year's budget. Mayor Todd stated that the quote was good for 30 days, the council could table if they so pleased and vote next council meeting, but the computers would have to be installed prior to the August 1, 2026 in order for the water treatment plan to continue to operate. Salazar reported Jetco has a 6-8 week lead time. Motion made by Prior to purchase now, second Tompkins. Harris – yes, Prior – yes, Sparrow – no, Mapel – yes, Tompkins – yes. Approved.

**Street – Withs, Driveways, Retaining walls – Right of Ways, sidewalks –** Mayor Todd had requested the Streets and Sidewalks committee meet to discuss. The committee has not met, the aforementioned topics were discussed at present. The council agreed that the street minimum width should be 22 feet except for alleys. Council will need to research the ability to change right of ways and return to discussing at a later meeting.

**Mayor Report –** Mayor Todd reported on the Farm to Market Road running through town. His understanding is that it would be best to request the county to remove Colton, Gamble, Springer, 2<sup>nd</sup> St, Maple, and Main st, the county would have to request that from the state board. Mayor Todd requested the council do some research and be ready to make a decision at the next council meeting. Mayor Todd reported the dog licenses are currently free, but the code book says \$10, we should make them consistent. The chicken license should also be reviewed and potentially raise the fine for loose chickens and roosters.
